FOREWORD

A project was launched in 2020 by the Gunners' Association of South Africa to record all heritage guns in the country.

An excellent initial register was developed in about 2010 by Pat Irwin of Grahamstown. His draft has been built on, expanded and at the time of writing now contains 548 guns of which 373 (68%) have been inspected in the past three years. There are 347 (63%) photos on this register and the data base which is kept in parallel with the register. Pat Irwin provided invaluable additional input in 2024, 2025 and 2026, including various pictures.

This project has been led by Maj Gen Roy Andersen (Ret) supported by Mrs Sharon Moyes and the Heritage Gun Restoration Committee. All the Gunners' Association branches have contributed to this project. Significant assistance has been received from the Ditsong SA National Museum of Military History, Springs Mine & Military Museum, the School of Artillery, GEM Village and the MOTH amongst others. Gnr Craig Nel inspected and photographed virtually every heritage gun in KZN.

The Register has been used as a basis for prioritising guns for restoration or at least respraying. Such work has been completed by the School of Artillery, 4 Artillery Regiment, Sandfontein Artillery Regiment, King Cetshwayo Artillery Regiment, GEM Village, Apex Base, Fort Klapperkop, Springs Mine and Military Museum and Ditsong SA National Museum of Military History. The Gunners' Memorial Trust has also ensured that all eight guns at the National Memorial in Potchefstroom have been resprayed.

Not surprisingly, the biggest number of guns in this register is the 25Pdr (GV1) gun which was used by the Defence Force from WWII through to the Angolan conflict. They are followed by the 3.7" Heavy AA gun, the 40mm QF Bofors LAA gun, the 3.7" Howitzer and the QF 13Pdr guns.

The location of the guns is varied and ranges from SANDF installations, museums and city halls to MOTH shellholes.





The guns vary in importance although this is a subjective assessment. Five of the 6" 26cwt guns that served with the Nugent Battery on the Western Front in WWI have been singled out and resprayed. They stand in the Company's Garden in Cape Town (Gunners' Memorial), Warriors Gate (MOTH HQ Durban), the Union Buildings, Kimberley Museum and the Johannesburg Zoo. The sixth gun is in a derelict state in Bloemfontein.

This Register will continue to be updated as more guns come to light and launchers will be restored to the extent the available funds permit.
